Summary

Heritage and environmental issues from past mine activity characterize many regions throughout the world. In this workshop results from research programs on mine environment funded by EU, USGS, PRIN, Sardinian Region and the Cagliari University, will be presented. Focus will be on tools applied to characterization and remediation in mine environments. Specific topics are hydrological tracer techniques, stable isotopes signatures, mobility of heavy metals, microbiological tools and phytoremediation.
