

Minimum information required in the mandate document indicating the Shipping company having ETS obligations

Each mandate can be drawn up freely, but shall include at least the following information:

- 1) For the **ISM Company** mandated by the Shipowner:
 - ✓ Name
 - ✓ IMO unique company and registered owner identification number
 - ✓ Country of registration (as recorded under the IMO Unique Company and Registered Owner Identification Number Scheme)

- 2) For the **Shipowner**:
 - Name
 - IMO unique company and registered owner identification number
 - Contact person (first name, last name, job title, business address, business telephone number, business email address)

- 3) For **each ship** falling within the scope of the mandate:
 - Ship name
 - IMO Ship number

- 4) The **date of application of the mandate** (dd/mm/yyyy) shall be indicated as 1st of January 2024, or as the date of the first voyage falling within the scope of Article 3ga of Directive 2003/87/EC. In case the ownership of a ship starts at a later date, the Shipowner shall indicate such date in the mandate for that ship.

- 5) Clear indication that the ISM Company has been duly mandated by the shipowner to **comply with the ETS obligations**.
