Abort a delayed transaction

Version 1: 01.12.2023

Italy

Transfers of allowances to accounts <u>not included</u> in the trusted list can be aborted while in status "*delayed*", up to two hours before their completion.

Pursuant to Article 35 paragraphs 5 and 6 of EU Delegated Regulation 2019/1122, in case of **suspected fraud**, an authorized account representative may abort a transfer or may request the national administrator to do so on his behalf. In both cases, the account holder must report the suspected fraud to the competent national law enforcement authority immediately following the request and forward such report to the national administrator within seven working days.

Assistance to abort a transfer must be requested no later than two hours before the transfer is completed, which means that the national administrator only abort transfers if requested by 10:00 am CET on the day of execution. The national administrator will accept requests to abort transfers only if forwarded via the <u>ARIET</u> website (TECHNICAL SUPPORT Request – "Abort transaction" topic). Requests on the phone are considered null and void. Users must be reachable for reconfirmation and any further questions on the mobile number they provided.
