Tutorial to operate in the Registry





New user registration

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Enrolment in the Union Registry consists of **two phases**: *registration* and *activation* of the user. Upon completion of the enrolment, the user will be able to access the Italian section of the Union Registry and operate within the account or accounts where s/he has been appointed to as an authorized representative (see page <u>How to enrol in the Registry</u> of the ARIET website).

This tutorial describes the <u>first</u> of the two phases for enrolling in the Registry: **REGISTRATION**.

To register, you must complete the following steps in order:

- 1. <u>Create an *account* in EU Login</u>;
- 2. Install the EU Login App on your mobile device;
- 3. Set up additional verification methods on your EU Login account;
- 4. Enter your personal details in the Registry.

For each consecutive step, follow the instructions in the tables

1 Create an account in EU Login

EU Login is the entry gate to sign in to different European Commission services (including the Union Registry) and/or other systems. EU Login verifies your identity and allows recovering your personal settings, history and access rights in a secure way.

Signing in requires creating a EU Login account, indicating a valid e-mail address and a password.



2 Install the EU Login App on your mobile device

To ensure a high level of security, access to the Registry and execution of processes require the use of a mobile device as a second verification method.

User identification via the mobile device is made possible thanks to a specific application installed on the device: the **EU Login App**.



Download and install the EU Login App on the mobile device you intend to use to access and operate in the Union Registry.

IMPORTANT!

During the installation of the EU Login App it is necessary to give ALL CONSENTS that are requested

The EU Login App is free and can be obtained from the Google Play Store (Android) or the App Store (iOS).

Some mobile devices may not be compatible with the EU Login App: if you encounter problems downloading the App, you can open a request of technical assistance (AST) in <u>ARIET</u> to receive assistance or more information.

3 Set up additional verification methods on your EU Login account

After installing the EU Login App, you will need to **add** a mobile number and the mobile device to your EU Login account: additional verification methods are **both necessary** to be operational.

3.1 Add a mobile number

Adding a mobile number to your EU Login account is crucial for resolving any issues that may occur at login, and as a fallback solution for accessing the Registry in the event of failure of the EU Login App.

Remember! Always keep the mobile number in your EU Login account updated, to avoid being unable to log in.





Hover your mouse over the gear icon next to your name and click My account







3.2 Add the mobile device

By initializing the EU Login App, the mobile device will be added to your EU Login account. Initialization generates a mobile unique device identifier (**MUDI**) which is stored in your account data. The MUDI then identifies a specific device that has been initialized, and will remain unchanged for that device until a new initialization is required.

If you are late in opening the notification and the QR code has expired, tap HELP in the orange bar and CLOSE

→ Repeat the steès from 10, more rapidly

If your device is equipped with **Fingerprint recognition**, an automatic pop up will be displayed to Enable Fingerprint recognition.

You can enable this function by clicking YES. If you do not want to enable Fingerprint recognition, click SKIP.

<u>Important:</u> it is possible to enable this function at a later time. Enter in EU Login Mobile App, tap Settings and select Start authentication via fingerprint

A notification on your device will inform you that your EU Login mobile App has been successfully initialized and can be used for authentication.



4 Enter your personal details in the Registry

After completing the first 3 steps, you can finally create your user profile in the Registry by accessing the system with the initialized device and filling in the online form with your personal details.

During this step the MUDI that identifies your device will be associated with the user profile you are creating, thus allowing the use of the mobile device as a second level of authentication to access and operate in the Registry (*soft token*).

IMPORTANT! Upon submission of the form, the system will assign you a unique identifier (**URID**): take note of your URID at the end of registration as you will have to provide it to the national administrator for each request in which you are appointed to a specific account as authorized representative.

PLEASE NOTE: at this point the user is in status "*registered*" and, when logging into the Registry, no access to any account is possible. When you are appointed to a specific account as authorized representative, the user passes to status "*validated*" and the system generates an **ENROLMENT KEY** which will be sent to you by the national administrator so that you can gain the status "*enrolled*" and be operational in the Registry (see the **User enrolment** tutorial on the <u>Tutorials and guides</u> page of the ARIET website).
